Fantoche 2025: the selection is final

In its 23rd edition, the International Animation Film Festival FANTOCHE in Baden presents current feature-length and short films for all ages, in addition to the themed focus programme "9 to 5" and the country focus Estonia. At the festival's core are nine competition programmes, divided into three categories: International, Swiss and Children's Film Competition. The Fantoche selection team has chosen 89 animated short films from a total of 3,050 submissions. Of these, 66 films will compete for 11 prizes. Outside of the competition, a further 23 short films will be screened in the "Panorama" programme. The full programme will be published on 12 August, when pre-sales will also begin.

In the International Competition, 32 films will compete for five prizes (Best Film, High Risk, Audience Award, Youth Award for Best New Talent, Flying Anidoc Award (the latter two awards are awarded across all three competitions)). This year, the winners of the "Best Film Award" can qualify for participation in the Academy Awards® and the BAFTA Awards for the first time – Fantoche has been both a BAFTA and an Oscar® qualifying festival since October 2024. With "Hunting", directed by Lea Favre, a Swiss film is also represented in the International Competition.

Preview: "9 to 5", Estonia, Industry Day on "Think Outside The Frame"

Inspired by Dolly Parton's classic, Fantoche presents animated films on the theme of work in the festival's focus programme "9 to 5". In shorts and feature films, a talk and an exhibition, the system of labour undergoes critical questioning and patriarchal and capitalist structures are put in the spotlight. Topics covered include unemployment, exploitation, trade union building, health at work and the role of women in the labour market.

The second focus is on animated filmmaking in **Estonia**. Like Switzerland, Estonia proves that artistic excellence and well-thought-out funding structures can enhance animation's global appeal. Filmmaker Helen Unt and art professor Lilli-Krōōt Repna have curated three captivating programmes laden with symbolic power, surreal images, contemporary aesthetics and existential themes. A talk with the curators and Estonian filmmakers will also shed light on the animated film scene in Estonia. As part of Industry Day, award-winning filmmaker Sander Joon ("Sierra") will give an Artist Talk.

"Think Outside the Frame" – disrupting familiar formats and thinking bigger about animation – is the motto of the 11th Industry Day, which takes place this year on Thursday 4 September. One of the programme highlights will be the presentation of the successful series "Arcane" by the French studio Fortiche. And this year, the best animated commissioned film in Switzerland will once again take home the Swiss Animation Industry Award (SAIA) – which will be presented during Industry Day.

The full festival programme will be published on 12 August, when pre-sales will begin.

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
